MISSION STATEMENT

We enable the NextGen to create purpose-driven internal networks within their corporates. We do this by creating cross-corporate connections, facilitating knowledge-sharing and enabling action.

WHO'S INVOLVED

This working group is open to people who work for corporates and who want to drive positive change by engaging their peers.

We believe that large corporates have the potential and the responsibility to drive positive change within the world. We were born out of connections made at One Young World, but are open beyond the Ambassador network.

Members are expected to actively participate in discussions, connect and share knowledge.

HOW IT WORKS

We offer three types of opportunities to connect:

Working group

What: Common collaborative space open to all members for discussion, document sharing and interaction

Why: Create and maintain connections, ask questions, share best practices & advice

How: Slack channel as the primary forum for discussion, supplemented by bi-monthly best-practice sharing calls led by 1-2 members and open to all

2

Roundtables

What: Small-group conversations focused on specific topics or challenge areas

Why: Allow topics to be explored further via deep-dive discussion, brainstorming and experience-sharing

How: Topics will be generated via the Slack channel and calls will be organized on a sign-up basis. Participants per call will be capped to allow for robust discussion

Task force

What: Specific project group working on a defined challenge/solution (i.e. event, concept, product, campaign)

Why: Turn discussion into action by facilitating intra/cross-corporate collaboration and partnership

How: A specific channel on Slack will be set up to allow members to share ideas and needs and connect on projects. Specifics will be determined by individual groups
